▶ **Let's pray together that God will prompt us to engage others in 'processing' what God is teaching or how He is leading.**

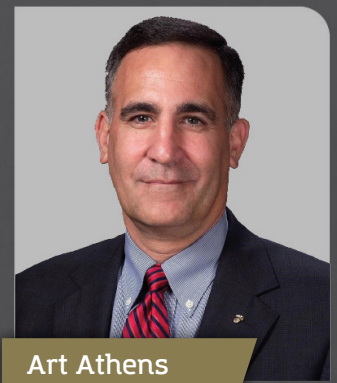
