The best result was that the men said, 'let's get together again soon to continue the conversation'. Each man agreed to pray for 'whatever God is doing here' and invite at least one other man who disciples men to our next conversation in August.

We know that African American men are actively engaged in reproducing discipleship. Sadly, the work God is doing is often overshadowed or overlooked. **Your prayers and finances are shining light in the right places.**
