Listen...

I'm learning. It's a slow process.

My tendency is to solve problems and fix things. I also love information and data. And, I love to be right. So, as I'm listening to someone, I'm often crafting an answer or response. Do you ever do this?

My natural inclination to share my thoughts or idea in rebuttal style is not typically helpful and often comes across as judgmental and confrontational. So, when a friend pointed me to Philippians 2, I camped out for a while.

Here are a few highlights...

In humility count others more significant than yourselves Philippians 2:3b. I need to follow this example more closely.

I also need to follow Jesus' example here...

But emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men and being found in human form, he humbled himself by become obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Philippians 2:7-8

We're living in a season of COVID stress and racial unrest. There is much value in doing what Jesus did... true manhood is willing to be empty, humble and obedient. Let's seek to listen, care and serve rather than speak and judge.
