# **CONFERENCES ARE GREAT, BUT...**

We just had our first **Noble Warriors Leader's Conference** (formerly Leading Noble Men) in four years! We're already seeing the impact on churches around the region. Michael Phillips, first-time attendee and men's ministry director from Chesapeake, said, "It was like drinking from a fire hydrant with the information provided... I plan to use the tools and strategies for our men's ministry." Phillips knows how to do an event, but now we can help equip leaders like him to have a great follow-up plan. He is opening the door for Mike to do some training and to reach more pastors in that area who could attend the conference next year and impact more men.

Conferences are one of the most visible aspects of our work, but I will let you in on something. That one day is not as important as what happens all the other days of the year.

We provide a one-day conference to create a catalytic event where the men can have a bigger, more impactful experience than what they could do as a single church in most cases, and it sends them out of there with a huge amount of momentum. They can return to their churches to do follow-up ministry and launch small groups or men's discipleship initiatives. Our objective is to help those churches launch or sustain their ongoing effort to see men discipled through the local church.

So, the conference ministry of Noble Warriors is impactful for one day, but the real win is what we can do downstream from our events. Conferences may be able to fund themselves, but we need ministry partners to invest in the work that goes on for the rest of the year. That work doesn't produce revenue. It has to be fed by those who believe in the mission.

Thank you for making it possible for us to serve these churches around the state as they each minister to the men God has placed in their midst.
